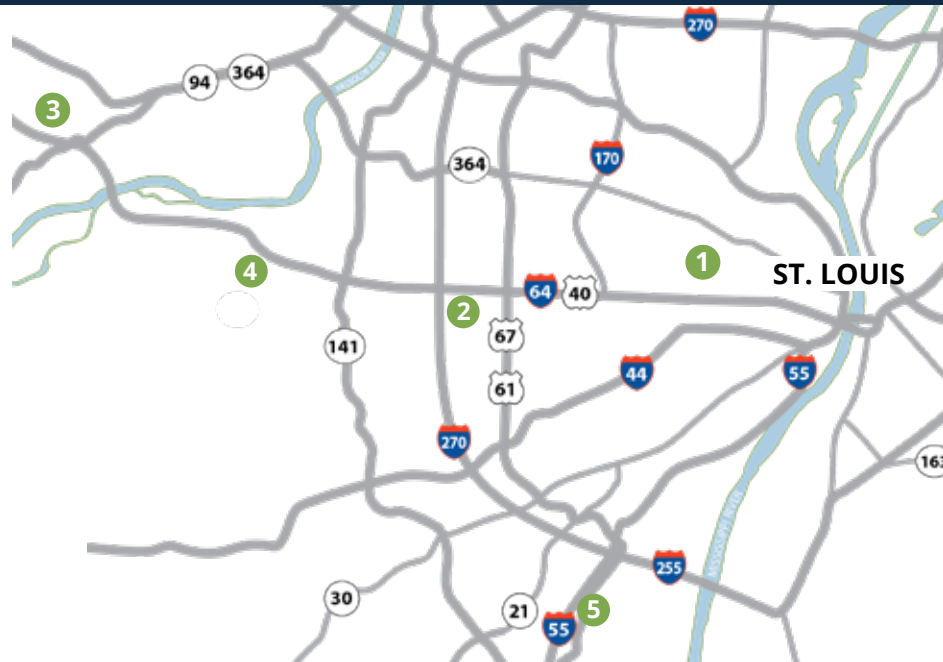


# Emergency care, just for kids
