



Forward-Facing Car Seat Answer Key

Picture or Question



Correct Answer

This picture shows the child being secured the wrong way. The harness clip should be at the armpit level.



This picture shows the child secured the right way.

This picture shows the child secured the wrong way. The harness strap is threaded too high. The harness strap should be threaded from the seat at or above the shoulder.



This picture shows the child secured the right way.





This picture shows the child secured the wrong way. The harness is too loose. You should not be able to pinch the harness straps above the harness clip between two fingers.

The safest practice is to secure a 14 month old toddler in a forward facing car seat.

This statement is wrong. The safest practice is to keep a child in a rear facing car seat until at least age 2.

When you hold the car seat near the belt path, you should be able to move the car seat NO MORE than 1 inch from side to side.

This statement is right.
