Correct Answer



This picture shows the child secured the **right** way.



This picture shows the child secured the **wrong** way. Harness straps should be threaded through the seat at or below the shoulders.



This picture shows the child secured the **wrong** way. Harness clip should be placed at the armpit level.



This picture shows the child secured the **right** way.



This picture shows the child secured the **wrong** way. The harness is too loose. You should not be able to pinch the harness straps above the harness clip between two fingers.

The safest practice is to move an infant in a rear facing car seat to a forward facing seat at age 1.

This statement is **wrong**. The safest practice is to keep a child in a rear facing car seat until at least age 2.

When you hold the car seat near the belt path, you should be able to move the car seat **NO MORE** than 1 inch from side to side.

This statement is **right**.
