

Holiday Donations to St. Louis Children's Hospital

Thank you for making a donation to ensure every child is able to celebrate the holidays—even when hospitalized. This year, new, packaged, and unwrapped toys and gift cards will be accepted from community donors, organizations, and toy drives from **Dec. 7–20** at BJC @ the Commons, just a few blocks east of the hospital.

Please note, we are unable to accept donations at the St. Louis Children's Hospital main campus during the holiday season. Additionally, due to infection prevention and patient confidentiality guidelines, delivering items directly to patients is not possible.

Suggested items for donation

- Teen gifts: Lego[™] sets, sports apparel, and spa items are highly requested
- Infant toys: Board books, rattles, and light-up toys are highly requested

Donations will be used to create a toy store in the hospital where families with children admitted over the holiday season can shop free of charge. They will also be used to celebrate important childhood milestones, including holidays and birthdays, commemorate treatment milestones, and brighten our patients' day when they need it the most.

Guidelines for donations

- · All donated toys and items must be new and in the original packaging. Used toys and items cannot be given to patients.
- · Please do not gift wrap donations.
- We are unable to accept:
 - Play guns, Nerf[™] guns, or other toy weapons
 - Latex balloons
 - Candy, gum, or other food
 - Scary or violent action figures or dolls
 - Handmade items


